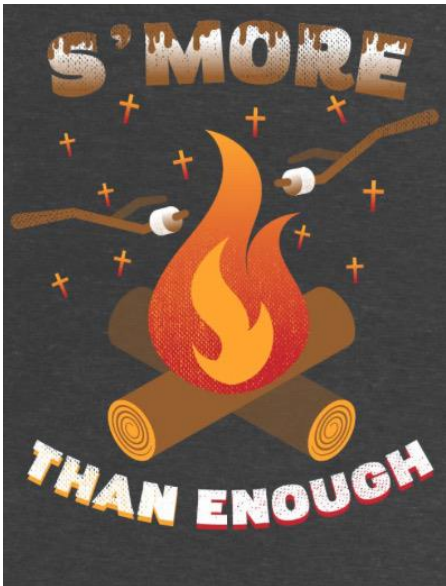
### Vacation Bible School Sign-Up Information

## **DID YOU KNOW?**

**Lutheran World Relief (LWR)** is a global organization that has already pledged over 7 million dollars for the humanitarian crisis in Ukraine. LWR has partnered with facilities in Ukraine to shelter displaced persons and provide food, beds, quilts, heaters, soap, and personal hygiene products for up to 60,000 nights of shelter.
