Hours – Up to 20 Hours per Week (with Sunday presence expected)

Compensation – Pay Range \$15-20 per hour

Position Description

All Saints is seeking an **Adult Leader** for our Faith Formation Team. This person will assist the Faith Formation Team in recruiting volunteers, while also developing, implementing, and administering faith formation ministry with an emphasis on adult ministry. This person will be an effective leader who will work with other church leaders to address the needs and opportunities for adults to grow as Christian disciples.

This Adult Leader will advocate that all are welcome and expected to be vital participants in all aspects of the ministry of All Saints Lutheran Church. This Adult Leader will raise congregational awareness of the needs and contributions of adults in the community and the world.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Create regular opportunities to encourage adult connections including, but not limited to, book studies, learning opportunities, guest presentations, etc.
- Be attentive to the hopes, concerns, and needs of the greater Worthington community to determine how the congregation might serve them. Work with outside service organizations to meet community needs (examples would be Lutheran Social Services, Habitat for Humanity, etc.) Identify key people at All Saints and in the community for collaboration and expansion of opportunities for all adults.
- Publicize educational and faith development opportunities through the worship bulletin, newsletter, weekly emails, bulletin boards, website, etc.
- Be familiar with All Saints' mission and vision in order to grow our ministry for and with adults.
- The Faith Formation Team covers all age groups and is a team effort. As time, demands, and interest levels allow, the Adult Leader may be involved in projects/events outside of the Adult-Ministry focus. Some examples are Church Festivals, Vacation Bible School, Service Events, Funeral Meals, etc.

Characteristics and Gifts

- Christ-centered and growing in faith in a God who is inclusive of all people and who sends people to make the world more reflective of God's compassion, justice, and love.
- Effective at communicating with adults of all ages.
- Effective leadership, organizational, and motivational skillset.
- Possess an excitement to develop volunteer teams to help support adult ministries.
- Attention to detail, yet flexible in last-minute situations.
- College degree or in pursuit of same.
